

Appendix A: Setup Requirements

Interactive Biodiversity-themed Show

Lily's Wild Arabian Adventure

- Space for a whole year group of students to sit, like an auditorium or a multi-purpose hall.
- If in a multi-purpose hall, a 2-metre distance between the first row of children and the performance area.
- If in a multi-purpose hall, access to power.
- If in an auditorium, access to link our wireless microphone to the stage system and to project visuals on the stage screen; a tech team member from school to assist in the setup of the microphone and screen.

Interactive Space-themed Show

Oh, the Solar System!

- Space for a whole year group of students to sit, like an auditorium or a multi-purpose hall.
- If in a multi-purpose hall, a 2-metre distance between the first row of children and the performance area.
- If in a multi-purpose hall, access to power.
- If in an auditorium, access to link our wireless microphone to the stage system and to project visuals on the stage screen; a tech team member from school to assist in the setup of the microphone and screen.
